The possible options for the housing to be built at the craftsman's mall property has gotten pretty confusing. I will try my best to offer my opinion. First of all one of the main reasons the neighbors (ACRH) didn't want one of Amcal's housing projects was because of their desire for very high occupancy. A project with 800 beds or higher is not what the nearby neighbors want to contend with. At this point I would like to see them keep the number of overall beds at 600 with mixed occupancy, including student families, staff and faculty. I could see some value in on-site diversification by offering a wide range of university managed housing types. Please reject a project with 800 beds.
